

The Most High God: Yahweh of Hosts: Jesus Christ, The King of Glory, Rules: Yahweh Rules Before All Time, And Now, And For All Eternity: Amen (8 of 12)!!!

“For Yahweh Most High is to be feared. He is a great King over all the earth” (Psalm 47:2). “Sing praise to God, sing praises. Sing praises to our King, sing praises. written in the law? How do you read [understand] it?' The expert answered, 'You shall love the Lord your God **with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind [i.e., All of you, to the fullest as Yahweh endowed you; the first commandment]; and your neighbor as yourself [the second commandment]**'. He [Jesus] said to him, 'You have answered correctly. Do this, and you will live'. But the expert, wanting/desiring to justify himself, asked Jesus, 'Who is my neighbor?' Jesus answered, 'A certain man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and he fell into the hands of robbers, who both stripped him and beat him, and departed leaving him half dead. By chance a certain priest was going down that way. When he saw the injured man, he passed by on the other side. In the same way a [certain] Levite also, when he came to the place, and saw him, passed by on the other side. But **a certain Samaritan**, as he traveled, came to where the injured man was. When he saw him, **he was moved with compassion [love your neighbor as yourself], came to him, and bound up his wounds, pouring on oil and wine. He set him on his own animal,**

and brought him to an inn, and took care of him. On the next day, when he departed, **he took out two denarii, and gave them to the host, and said to him, "Take care of him. Whatever you spend beyond that, I will repay you when I return."** Now which of these three do you think seemed to be a neighbor to him who fell into the hands of robbers? The expert in religious law said, 'The one who showed mercy on him.' **Then Jesus said to him, "Go and do likewise."** (Luke 10: 25-37).

"Remember your compassionate and faithful deeds, O Lord, for you have always acted in this manner" (Psalm 25:6): "**Moved with compassion, Jesus touched their eyes.** Immediately they received their sight (Matthew 20:34): "**Moved with compassion, Jesus stretched out his hand and touched him,** saying, 'I am willing.
